Proposed webinar format

Each 90-minute session is divided into two webinars given by two PhD students from two Alliance universities. Each webinar lasts 45 minutes, including a 30-minute presentation and a 15-minute discussion with the audience. This presentation lies somewhere between a popularization exercise, an oral conference and a sharing of experience.

The presentation could include:

- an introduction to the scientific material needed to understand your research topic
- the general context of your research
- the main results you have obtained, highlighting the obstacles and breakthroughs you have encountered
- the perspectives of your research in other directions or fields, and finally
- a more general discussion about your profession as a researcher, your expertise, and the way you see the role of researchers in society.
