

Announcement regarding the opening of the ERASMUS selection for teaching mobilities within the CIVIS project "Bridging Europe with Africa through Applied Chemistry Research and Education"

The Faculty of Chemistry of the University of Bucharest, in collaboration with its partner universities in Africa, is launching the selection for teaching mobility within the *Bridging Europe with Africa through Applied Chemistry Research and Education* project, funded through the *CIVIS Seed Funding for Research Activities and African-European Collaboration 2024* call.

Purpose of the selection:

This selection aims to facilitate the participation of academic staff from partner universities in Africa (University of the Witwatersrand, South Africa, and Université Hassan II de Casablanca, Morocco) in the networking event that will take place in Bucharest, in the period May 26-30, 2025. Their participation will contribute to strengthening academic and scientific collaboration between Europe and Africa in the field of applied chemistry.

Number of available mobilities:

- 2 mobilities for University of the Witwatersrand, South Africa
- 2 mobilities for Université Hassan II de Casablanca, Morocco

- **Announcement of the preliminary results of the selection:** April 4, 2025 after 14:00 EET
- **Contestation deadline:** April 7, 2025 at 14:00 EET
- **Announcement of the final results of the selection:** April 7, 2025 after 14:00 EET
- **Mobility period:** May 26-30, 2025 (the event will take place at the University of Bucharest)

Required application documents:

- Copy of the Passport with valid visa
- Updated CV (in English)
- List of relevant recent publications in the field of applied chemistry
- Teaching plan for the mobility – established in agreement with the project coordinator
- Evidence of participation in activities within CIVIS alliance
- Any other relevant documents supporting the application

Eligibility criteria:

- The candidate must be an active academic or researcher from one of the following partner universities in Africa: University of the Witwatersrand, South Africa, or Université Hassan II de Casablanca, Morocco.
- The candidate must demonstrate relevant experience and contributions in the field of applied chemistry research.
