WP1: Management & Tools (AMU)



Objectives:

- Provision of effective and efficient technical, legal, administrative and financial project management.
- Develop a CIVIS Platform that will support cooperation and the sharing of information within CIVIS.
- Lay the foundations for an efficient joint administration of CIVIS European University in the long-term.

Our Digital campus:

- Platform Cooperation tools: administrative intranet, Open Labs and hubs platforms (cooperation tools), CIVIS programs and international partnerships databases, Mobility assistance portal, Innovative Pedagogies database, tools and courses for virtual mobility, multilingual tools
- Support the implementation of the CIVIS European Student Card.

WP2: Governance & Deployment (AMU & ULB)



Objectives:

- Ensure a long-term structure for a sustainable European University Alliance.
- Involve all stakeholders from our respective universities and from external organisations who will benefit from the CIVIS Alliance, and whose involvement will benefit our Alliance and internal stakeholders.
- Operationalise a cooperation that reflects the vitality of our communities and their ownership of our European University Alliance.
- Support the deployment of CIVIS as a model of a European University in a European Education Area.

Governance, a step by step approach:

Creation of a Board of Rectors, a Steering Commitee, a Participative Council, a Consultative Council, and also a CIVIS legal entity, A CIVIS administration with its own Secretary General

Deployment:

- 1) European level: monitoring of CIVIS activities and regular exchanges with the EACEA Agency about CIVIS results and identified barriers
- 2) National level: sticking points related to national regulations



WP3: Local engagement & territorial impact (UAM)



Objectives:

- Connect CIVIS education, research and innovation to local needs and challenges.
- Contribute to **local dialogues** around local problems, bringing research, innovation, education and, where useful, public-private partnerships, to bear on the search for solutions.
- Provide CIVIS students with a range of pedagogically sound, **service learning projects** that foster civic engagement and transversal skills.
- Nurture territorial ecosystems and regional development.
 - Project Incubator
 - Seed funding
 - Service Learning activities (TU)
 - Contribute to 3S and to value chains among our regions



WP4: European Hubs (SU)



Objectives:

- Develop CIVIS "Hubs" that draw on the assets of all CIVIS Alliance partners.
- Offer multi-disciplinary and individualised learning pathways to **undergraduates and postgraduates** in the CIVIS member universities.
- **Link** these learning pathways to excellent research and technologies within the Alliance, as well as to external stakeholders, partnerships and funding sources
- Recognise and stimulate students' participation in CIVIS member Universities' respective educational offers.
 - > Seed funding for Workshops and projects: Knowledge triangle + Civic engagement + Med/AFR
 - At least 3 hubs over the 3 yrs + Hubs admin & scientist coordinators
 - > Task forces: research and academic affairs
 - CIVIS track (certificate?)

WP5: Mediterranean and African partnerships (TU)

Objectives:

- Developping and forging partnerships with « mirror » universities in the Mediterranean and African regions
- Address with these partners challenges of joint interest to find joint solutions

Ideas:

- Five Mirror Hubs in the Mediterranean basin and in Africa to develop challenge-based education and research between the alliance and universities of these areas
- Possible education and research programmes supported by the EU-Africa partnership
- Partnerships for developing digital skills around the Mediterranean (...)

Objectives:

- Enable seamless and multi-dimensional mobility models that will enable 10% student mobility by 2022 (12.000)
- Achieve 50% student mobility within the Alliance by 2025
- Foster the creation of an inter-university campus
 - Academic incentives by each University (x6: 1500 mobility) / 20% European Doctorate Label
 - Lowering the cost of mobility: 1200 short-term mob + 120 virtual mobility measures or courses (5 WP7)
 - Logistical aspects of mobility: pre-departure training, system of home hospitality, provide information through an e-platform

Academic incentives

University-wide Erasmus exchange agreements between each of the eight member universities

Long mobility between CIVIS member universities: 1,500 students (BA, MA and PhD) over 3 years

Specific actions to increase mobility include:

- Earmarking of c. 25% of the University's internalisation funding to mobilities within the CIVIS alliance (e.g. UAM, TU and AMU mobility plans)
- Inclusion of compulsory mobility in programmes at BA and MA levels
- Providing automatic recognition of credits for student mobility projects (e.g. NKUA, SUR, SU, UB)
- Facilitating and streamlining the quality evaluation and automatic recognition of our joint learning pathways.





















Shorter and flexible mobility linked to Hub educational offers and Open Labs

1,200 short mobilities either 'stand-alone' or blended :

- One-week workshops on specific subjects, including visiting professors, corresponding to a set number of credits, included in the academic record.
- Summer Schools in the Hub thematic areas, including combined mobility programs.
- Blended mobility programs, combining virtual and short intensive physical mobility.



















Innovative virtual mobility for all

120 virtual mobility courses, 10 000 students participating

Aims:

- 1. Increase the educational offer by "bringing in" courses from other CIVIS Universities
- 2. Support maintaining or developing linguistic competences

CIVIS mobility task force will:

- Develop a catalog of courses available CIVISwide
- Identify themes for 'student interactive conferences' and/ or virtual joint projects;
- Determine the cultural or linguistic dimension included in courses;
- Promote these courses to students across the Alliance.





















WP7: CIVIS Teaching Excellence (UB)

Objectives:

- Support staff in developping innovative tools for the CIVIS joint educationnal offer
- Enable a step change in the number, quality and diversity of virtual mobilities
- Support students' ability to learn and work in a multilingual environment

- Innovative pedagogies module (benchmark + dvpt)
- Virtual mobilities: 120 courses (5/uni/yr)
- Multilingual tools (catalog & dvpt)
- > Staff mobility for Task forces

- Staff: 2 WP leader + admin staff (R)
- 3 Task forces: innovative pedagogies, ML, entrepreneurial skills
- Virtual collaboration systems (35K€/univ)
- UB Staff mobility for training













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WP8: Quality & Evaluation (SUR)

Objectives:

- Ensure the quality and effectiveness of actions undertaken as part of the CIVIS project
- Assess the efficiency of the project with respect to its stated objectives
- Assess quality of teaching activities undertaken within CIVIS WPs
- Articulate the level of quality of learning ans research projects, and communicate internally and externally

- Produce a Quality handbook and an Annual report of results
- Establish a CIVIS label and award, a yearly CIVIS prize to 3-5 remarkable initiatives linked to the member universities (prize = mobility)
